**What:** Urgent carriageway resurfacing and patching  
**Where:** Cotton's Lane, Tetbury - see overleaf for details of the exact location  
**When:** 10<sup>th</sup> April 2017  
**Times:** Monday 08:00hr to 16.30hr (the road will be under long delays with limited access maintained to your properties)

On behalf of Gloucestershire County Council, Amey will be undertaking emergency patching and resurfacing work at the above location.

Over recent months there have been a number of pot holes and carriageway edge failures causing a rapid decline in the overall condition of the road. In order to keep the road safe, it will be necessary to undertake urgent repair work.

To ensure the safety of road users and our workforce, it will be necessary for us to **work under long delays** because of the road width and machinery that will be used. Overleaf is a map showing the road closure area.

**We hope you understand that we will not be able to allow access for vehicles in or out of our road closure (see red line on map overleaf) except in emergencies. If you normally drive into or out of this area during the hours when the closure will be in place, we ask you to please make alternative arrangements. Please also avoid leaving parked vehicles on the road. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout.**
