A representative from Tetbury Area Youth and Community Trust introduced themselves to the new councillors and gave a brief overview of the trust. They produced a document which summarises what they have delivered and achieved in 2022-23 and outlined the proposal for the youth holiday provision for 2023-24. TAYCT propose that they will continue to co-ordinate and advertise a programme of school holidays events and activities for children, young people and families in Tetbury and all activities will be free to attend. They will continue to develop a network of partner organisations that enable a variety of enrichment opportunities and events throughout the year.

Tetbury Area Youth and Community Trust asked for a grant of £5000 from the Health, Wellbeing and Youth Committee to contribute towards youth holiday provision in Tetbury from August 2023-July 2024.

It was proposed by Councillor Z Baker seconded by Councillor N Ind to approve the grant of £5000 to Tetbury Area Youth and Community Trust.

Following the visit from the Community Support Officer (Physical Activity) from Cotswold District Council (CDC) to the Friendship Café, Fitness bands and balls have been kindly donated by CDC and one of the volunteers at the Friendship Café has agreed, with the support of the Community Support Officer to lead a fitness session each month.

The Reverend from St Mary's Church brought along eight students from Sir William Romney's School to the Friendship Café who were accompanied by their RE teacher. They wanted to demonstrate to the students how important community is and how groups like the Friendship Care are much needed in our towns/communities.

Gloucestershire Rural Community Council (GRCC) have gratefully donated two free laptops and dongles to use at the Friendship Café. A log of what people are using them for ie booking doctor appointments, online shopping etc and the information will then be shared with Daisi partnership (Digital Accessibility, Inclusion Support and Innovation) which comes under a wider umbrella for GRCC and partnership working. HWY12. 06/23 To note update on Digital Technology Course for Older People

Digital Technology Course for Older People will be a 12-week course led by Adult Education with one tutor and four volunteers. Each session will teach new skills from how to keep yourself safe online, how to do online mobile banking and how to keep in touch with messaging, phone calls and video calls. With the support of the Community Builder Cotswold from Cotswold District Council we are hoping to run this free Digital Technology Course in September and start dates are currently being discussed.

Due to personal circumstances Tetbury Shop Mobility in its current format is seeking another organisation to take the facility over.

The scooters and wheelchairs are currently being stored at St Saviours Church in Tetbury but it is highly likely a new storage will need to be found.

Councillor S Scott will discuss with Tetbury Area Youth and Community Trust regarding taking over the administration and Councillor P Leech said that Tetbury Tesco's may be willing to store the mobility scooter's and wheelchair's but cannot be responsible for the insurance and maintenance.
