HWY11. 07/23 To note update on regarding Health, Wellbeing & Youth Event 2023 Celebration of Tetbury:

Councillor N Ind gave a verbal update - Cotswold District Council have confirmed that we do not need to obtain a Temporary Event Notice as no alcohol will be served by Tetbury Town Council.

Organisations attending the event will use the entrance in Sherwood Road and can arrive from 11:00 (Residents of Sherwood Road to receive a letter from Tetbury Town Council making them aware of the extra vehicles using the road). Vehicles will park on the Muga as requested by Dolphins Recreation Committee Trust (DRCT).

The First Aid team have asked if they can have their car by their post on the recreation ground and approval for this will be required from DRCT.

The carnival will enter the recreation ground using Hampton Street entrance approximately 13:10. The classic car and motorbikes will do one lap of the recreation ground before they park in their allocated spots for the afternoon.

Councillor N Ind will discuss with the Carnival Committee what the percentage will be taken from the commercial organisations on the day and to be donated to the Dolphins Recreation Committee. Vehicles will be able to vacate the site from 5pm.

HWY07. 07/23 To note Health and Wellbeing Co-ordinator report

A member from Gloucestershire Carers Hub came to the Friendship Café and explained to the group that if you support a partner, relative or friend who is disabled or ill due to physical or mental health what benefits there are by registering with the Carers Hub and how they can access free information, guidance, support to empower the in their caring role.

Our local PSCO visited too and made everyone aware, that there has recently been a lot of handbag thefts in Tetbury Tesco's and advised that for safety to attach a bell keyring and to remain vigilant.

We had another fitness session using the fitness bands and this was led by a Cotswold District Council Community Support Officer (Physical Activity) & Community Builder and one of our volunteers. Many keenly joined in and lots of laughter could be heard.

In June the Health and Wellbeing Co-ordinator attended the Food Poverty Report in Cirencester and reported their key findings and how Cirencester Foodbank has provided 4,724 emergency food parcels during April 2022-March 2023 and 2,190 parcels went to children aged 16 and under. In January 2023 they were pleased to be able to move to a larger space at Christ Church, which allowed them to launch Tetbury Foodbank plus centre. This new hub has enabled them to improve the provision of support from the foodbank's volunteer signposting team which is another great asset to for our Town.

HWY12. 07/23 Correspondence Received:

Westonbirt Arboretum Community Access Scheme advised TTC had 85 visits outstanding, and these needed to be used by the end of July. 25 visits will be allocated to the Friendship Café and the remaining will be offered to all using an Eventbrite ticketing platform and advertised on social media.

The Health & Wellbeing was introduced to the Director of Seniors' Service through the Senior Client Services Manager at Upton Mill Care Home in Tetbury. The Seniors' Services are a company who help navigate the challenges of later life such as - wills, lasting powers of attorney, attendance allowance, blue badge applications etc. Cllr S Scott would like to research into our liabilities as a Council if we introduce a commercial company by inviting them to attend the Friendship Café. The Health and Wellbeing Co-ordinator will enquire the cost if the Seniors' Service is used.

The Health and Wellbeing Co-ordinator has been invited to attend Holiday@Home on Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th August to talk about the Friendship Café and other things that are provided by Tetbury Town Council.

Scottish & Southern Electricity Networks have launched their latest Resilient Communities Fund; enabling communities across central southern England to apply for awards that will help them to build resilience in their community if they are faced with prolonged power interruptions. This information will be shared with organisations in our town.
