Tetbury Area & Youth Community Trust Shared that they had six events over the Easter holidays and how popular the Tea & Toast sessions are for the young people.

They are still looking for storage for the Shopmobility wheelchairs and mobility scooters and they are aware that they need to be removed from St Saviours as soon as possible. They are continuing to work with Tetbury Tesco's regarding having storage there and are waiting for head office to approve this.
