HWY03. 06/24 To receive a presentation from Cirencester Foodbank:

The Participation and Engagement Lead from Cirencester Foodbank gave a presentation on food insecurity and how people in smaller communities find it hard to ask for support. Tetbury is the first town to pilot Foodbank + Hub, which offers a wraparound support with Citizens Advice and P3 charity who are available at the Hub every Tuesday 11am until 1pm at the Christchurch in the Chipping.

The committee were provided with the following statistics –

There has been a 19% increase in the number of people using the Foodbank in Tetbury, in the last year. (2022/23 – 2023/24) and the number of people receiving more than 6 in a year has risen by 6% this year (2023 / 24)

- Any funding allocated to this aspect of our youth work would supplement existing resources for each session and enable our team to plan more meal cooking activities more often, creating more opportunities for young people to get involved and have a go.

It was proposed by Councillor Z Baker seconded by Councillor R Smith to allocate £1,170 of the Great Tythe Barn donation to TAYCT for a weekly youth cooking activity.

The remaining £422.64 will be held by Tetbury Town Council for a future food project.
