**HWY07. 01/25 To receive an update on Christmas Day Lunches within our community:**

The committee felt that the delivery of lunches and warm bags on Christmas Day went smoothly and was grateful to the community who also volunteered on the day. HWC reported that she had received and read some heartfelt messages from those who received the lunches, and those recipients wanted to thank everyone who gave up their time to make the deliveries.

**HWY09. 01/25 To note the Health and Wellbeing Co-ordinator report:**

Following Gloucestershire County Council's decision not to renew the recommissioning of the Community Wellbeing Service, the HWC was invited to meet the new Social Prescribing Team at Phoenix Surgery in South Cerney. The South Cotswold Primary Care Networks (PCN) voted to bring social prescribing in-house. They hope to have the Social Prescribing service available by the end of January 2025.

HWC was involved in a meeting with the Health Visitor and another organisation to discuss how to reach out to individuals who are temporarily residing in Tetbury and may require a visit from the Health Visitor. An information sheet has been created providing information on who to contact and where to get support.

**HWY10. 01/25 To receive a report from the Health, Wellbeing and Youth Working Group:**

Cllr Z Baker explained that the role for a new chair has arisen for the Health, Wellbeing and Youth working group.

A new bench near the Royal Oak will be sited thanks to donations received from the Coventry Building Society.

St Mary's School raised money from their Community Singing which will be donated to Shelter. 'I Sing Pop' sessions held at St Mary's School on Sunday afternoons will continue this year.

TAYCT will be advertising for a Youth Worker.

**HWY11. 01/25 Correspondence Received:**

An email was received from Cirencester Foodbank thanking everyone for their kind donations. They reported that they had provided 3750 parcels in 2024 and supported Foodbank clients to achieve more than £220,000 in financial outcomes which means they are no longer reliant on using Foodbanks.

Cotswold District Council are holding 'Strengthening Communities Events' throughout the Cotswolds. Tetbury's event will be held on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> May 3pm until 6pm at the Dolphins Hall. There will be free fun activities for children, young people and adults including arts and crafts.

World Jungle are in discussion with TAYCT regarding bringing the Big Top tent to Tetbury in the summer and they are keen to explore ways it could support several community events over a weekend.
