

**GLoucestershire County Council Temporary Closure of Public
Bridleways NLN 21 & 23, NTU 47 & 48 (Long Newnton and Tetbury
Upton Parishes) Cotswold District
Order 2025**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council (“the Council”) being the Traffic Authority for the Public Bridleways NLN 21 & 23, NTU 47 & 48 as described more particularly in the schedule below (“the Bridleways”) is satisfied that use of the Bridleways should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near them

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 12th day of July Two Thousand and Twenty Five and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months;
2. This Order may be cited as “Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure of Public Bridleways NLN 21 & 23, NTU 47 & 48 (Long Newnton and Tetbury Upton Parishes) Cotswold District Order 2025

GENERAL

3. Except for emergency and pedestrian access to premises no person shall proceed on foot, horseback, or bike, nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Bridleways;
4. The Bridleways fall in the Parishes of Long Newnton and Tetbury Upton in the Cotswold District in the County of Gloucestershire.

Schedule

Public Bridleway NTU 48 from its junction with Newnton Hill at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) ST 90889/94814 extending in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 90 metres to its junction with NLN 23 at (OSGR) ST 90866/94737 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B.

Public Bridleway NLN 23 from its junction at NTU 48 at OSGR ST 90866/94737 extending in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 200 metres to its junction with NTU 47 at (OSGR) ST 90788/94555 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked B to C.

Public Bridleway NTU 47 from its junction at NLN 23 at OSGR ST 90788/94555 extending in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 850 metres to its

junction with NLN 21 at (OSGR) ST 90285/93894 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked C to D.

Public Bridleway NLN 21 from its junction at NTU 47 at OSGR ST 90285/93894 extending in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 35 metres to it's junction with NLN 24 at (OSGR) ST 90265/93861 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked D to E.

The Public Bridleways fall within the Parishes of Long Newnton and Tetbury Upton in the Cotswold District in the County of Gloucestershire.
